Tiger Truck Receives Award on National TV

14 November 2005 – Dallas, TX – As seen by millions on Friday, November 11, on the American Life Television Network, Tiger Truck received the “Keeping America Strong Award.” Kevin F. Delaney, Rear Admiral, US Navy (ret.) made the presentation to Michael S. Ward, Sr., Founder and CEO of Tiger Truck. In his remarks, Adm. Delaney noted that Tiger is *“the perfect example of the innovative spirit that is the backbone of the U.S. free enterprise system.”* Among the other laudatory comments, Tiger was praised for *“finding creative ways to conserve energy”* and *“operating with a concern for preserving the environment.”* Ward complimented his *“dealer network for being so responsive to customer needs”* and his development team for *“delivering broad powerplant choices: all-electric, E-85, gasoline and hybrids.”*

This presentation was made at the conclusion of a 30-minute television program produced by William Shatner and narrated by Doug Llewellyn, called the “Heartbeat of America.” The series showcases the best examples of innovative U.S. businesses as they create new products and processes that keep the U.S. economy robust. In response to a question about the off-road vehicles being disadvantaged when restricted to off-road use, Ward observed that *“our vehicles have a decided advantage being slightly smaller in footprint and governed not to exceed 25 mph, the typical speed limit enforced on most military compounds. Then there are private residential developments, shopping centers, golf courses and college campuses where only these vehicles are permitted on the sidewalks and close to buildings.”*
